Botswana is the ultimate destination for a luxury safari, combining magnificent wildlife, spectacular scenery, traditional culture with comfortable and stylish lodges. On this nine day journey you will experience the Moremi Reserve, famed for its game, Okavango Delta, the world's largest inland delta, and Chobe National Park, the most diverse of Botswana's parks. You may like to add or remove days from this example itinerary according to your interests, or you could add on a few extra days to visit the spectacular Victoria Falls.

DAY 1

London/Johannesburg

Depart in the evening on a British Airways overnight flight from London Heathrow to Johannesburg.

DAY 2

Johannesburg/Moremi

On arrival in Johannesburg, connect with your onward flight to Maun from where a short flight in a light aircraft takes you to the heart of the Moremi Reserve. Your home for the next three nights is Sanctuary Chief's Camp, an exclusive lodge with 12 luxurious, private bush pavilions overlooking the plains or, seasonally, the lagoons.

DAY 3 AND 4

Moremi

Sanctuary Chief's Camp is set on raised ground - in the rainy season it becomes an island and at other times



offers spectacular views over the plains - well positioned for an abundance of wildlife sightings; cheetah, leopard and occasionally hunting packs of wild dogs are spotted. Two days of morning and evening game drives and seasonal trips by mokoro (subject to water levels) are an unforgettable way to experience the remarkable sights of nature.

DAY 5

Moremi/Okavango Delta

A short air transfer brings you to a beautiful area of the Delta. Here you have a choice of staying at either Sanctuary Baines' Camp or Sanctuary Stanley's Camp. Baines' has just five rooms and is located on a permanent water hole. Stanley's is a small and exclusive lodge



of just eight classic safari tents, sited at the very heart of a private concession of 104,000 hectares.

DAY 6

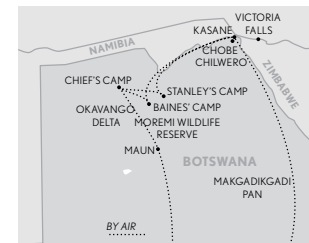
Okavango Delta

A full day in which to explore one of Africa's most beautiful regions; guided walking safaris are a special pleasure - buffalo, elephant, giraffe and lion are all regularly sighted. One of the highlights of any visit to this area is to walk with a herd of semi-habituated elephants, sharing and learning from their daily routine.

DAY 7

Okavango Delta/Chobe

After a light aircraft flight from the private airstrip to Kasane you will be driven to nearby Sanctuary Chobe Chilwero Lodge, overlooking the river and ➤

the flood plain of Chobe National Park. This luxurious lodge offers sophisticated comforts, including specialist spa treatments such as aromatherapy and massage, without compromising the atmosphere of an untouched wilderness region.

DAY 8 *Chobe*

Explore Chobe National Park today at your leisure, famous for large concentrations of elephant and buffalo. Game viewing is usually by open vehicles,

but there are waterborne safaris on the Chobe River where you may encounter crocodile and hippo as well as a startling range of birdlife. The river setting is perfect for a relaxing sundowner.

DAY 9 *Chobe/Johannesburg/London*

Leave Chobe today and transfer the short distance back to Kasane for your departure flight to Johannesburg. Your British Airways flight from Johannesburg arrives into London Heathrow early on day 10.



However, you may like to extend your stay by a few nights and take in the mighty Victoria Falls.

VICTORIA FALLS EXTENSION **DAY 9**

Chobe/Victoria Falls

Today you will be driven from Chobe to Victoria Falls, one of the natural wonders of the world. The choice is yours: stay in the colonial elegance of the Victoria Falls Hotel in the bustling town of Victoria Falls or, on the Zambian side of the falls, at Sanctuary Sussi & Chuma, a luxurious safari camp situated on the banks of the Zambezi.

DAY 10

Victoria Falls

Spend the day at the site of Africa's - arguably the world's - greatest waterfall,

known locally as Mosi-oa-Tunya ('The Smoke That Thunders'). The town close by is the hub of adventure activities: light aircraft and helicopters make thrilling sorties up the Batoka Gorge and through the spray of the Falls, white water rafting offers white-knuckle rapids shooting downstream, bungee jumpers leap from the bridge linking Zimbabwe and Zambia, whilst on the still waters above the Falls, boats embark on mellow sundowner cruises.

DAY 11

Victoria Falls/London

Transfer to the airport for your flight back to Johannesburg, where you will connect with an overnight British Airways flight, arriving London Heathrow early on day 12.
